Dear Friends,

Those who came down heavy and harsh over those who chose to endure. A divide between the oppressor and the oppressed! This vast divide will be visible and will manifest in various forms, obvious to all who see. The contrast is of light and darkness. The darkness is going to get thicker, the light will become more glorious. The Lord is passionate for Zion!

"Plague went before Him; pestilence followed his steps." (Habbakuk 3:5) The Lord is here. Those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. God will be their refuge and their fortress.

This ROAR edition, dated 1st May 2021 - is almost like a last call going out for many. Many of those who have rejected the corrections and warnings brought by the Lord until now, rejected accountability in life and the way of peace. Heed the word of the Lord and turn away from the coming perishing. Repentance is the ONLY way forward. Acknowledge! Acknowledge! Acknowledge!

*"This is what the Sovereign Lord says: Woe to you shepherds of Israel who only take care of yourselves! Should not shepherds take care of the flock? You eat the curds, clothe yourselves with the wool and slaughter the choice animals, but you do not take care of the flock. **You have not strengthened the weak or healed the sick or bound up the injured.** You have not brought back the strays or searched for the lost. **You have ruled them harshly and brutally.** This is what the Sovereign Lord says: I am against the shepherds and will hold them accountable for my flock. I will remove them from tending the flock so that the shepherds can no longer feed themselves. I will rescue my flock from their mouths, and it will no longer be food for them. "For this is what the Sovereign Lord says: I myself will search for my sheep and look after them. As a shepherd looks after his scattered flock when he is with them, so will I look after my sheep. I will rescue them from all the places where they were scattered on a day of clouds and darkness." (Ezekiel 34:2-4, 10-12 NIV)*

Just as the Lord released the captives and led them out of their own Egypts in 2020, the Lord is breaking the rod of the oppressor and the scepter of the wicked in 2021! In Isaiah 36 & 37 we read about the Assyrian king Sennacherib who seemed indomitable and bent upon capturing Israel – mocking her and coercing her to give in to the planned invasion. But as King Hezekiah sought refuge in the Lord, God came!

Israel that lived under constant terror of the Assyrians was delivered when God removed Sennacherib from the 'position' of an oppressor over Israel, forever. The Assyrian army fell without a fight – with over 185,000 dead in their camp! The oppressor was gone - overnight.



The coming days mark the end of an era of terror and oppression that God's people have gone through in various forms.

"You will think back to this time of terror, asking, "Where are the Assyrian officers who counted our towers? Where are the bookkeepers who recorded the plunder taken from our fallen city?" (Isaiah 33:18 NLT).

"See, a king will reign in righteousness and rulers will rule with justice. Each one will be like a shelter from the wind and a refuge from the storm, like streams of water in the desert and the shadow of a great rock in a thirsty land."

(Isaiah 32:1-2 NIV)

The righteous person who sins will not be allowed to live even though they were formerly righteous.’ **And if I say to a wicked person, ‘You will surely die,’ but they then turn away from their sin and do what is just and right— if they give back what they took in pledge for a loan, return what they have stolen, follow the decrees that give life, and do no evil— that person will surely live; they will not die.** None of the sins that person has committed will be remembered against them. They have done what is just and right; they will surely live. “Yet your people say, ‘The way of the Lord is not just.’ But it is their way that is not just.” (Ezekiel 33:12, 14-17 NIV)*

The Lord is looking for ACCOUNTABILITY. He is just and all His ways are fair. *“But I will judge each of you according to your own ways.”* (Ezekiel 33:20 NIV). **There is coming a wave of Repentance** over the Church before a great perishing. A wave that will sweep over those who choose to humble themselves and cry out to the Lord.

“Notice how God is both kind and severe. He is severe toward those who disobeyed, but kind to you if you continue to trust in his kindness. But if you stop trusting, you also will be cut off.” (Romans 11:22 NLT)

Call to Action: *“Against you, you only, have I sinned and done what is evil in your sight; so you are right in your verdict and justified when you judge.”* (Psalms 51:4 NIV)

The Lord reminds that it wasn’t against others, but against God Himself that His people sinned. May His people heed this call and know that Mercy is still available - May we not harden our hearts.

Those who have felt convicted and are willing to bend before the Lord, the Lord gently leads you to the prayer in Psalm 51.
